## How-To Install an Authenticator App on your Device for Two-Step Verification

If your site has Two-step Verification enabled then you'll be required to enter a security code everytime you log into Kahootz. In order to acquire a security code, you will first need to download and install an Authenticator App to your device. On your device, open the app store eg: Play Store for Android, Windows Store for Microsoft devices or App Store for iOS users.

There's also an app called Twilio Authy which is compatible with Mobile, Desktop & Chrome.

Note: The below steps have been completed on an Android device. Open "Play Store" and type "Authenticator" which will display a list of apps, I'll select "Microsoft Authenticator" and click install. Once it's finished downloading/installing, open the app and click the 3 dots in the top-right corner, select "add account" from the drop-down menu. Select other accounts (Google, Facebook, etc.) from the list which may ask for access to the camera, we recommend you select yes. Then point the camera at the QR code during the Two-Step Verification wizard when logging in for the first time. The account will now be added to the app which will display a unique 6 digit number that you'll need each time you log into Kahootz.
